


# Love Bugs Craft



## You will need:


- Egg carton
- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Black marker pen
- Pipe cleaner
- Coloured card: two colours
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Glue




1) First, use the scissors to cut each egg cup from the egg carton tray. Smooth the edges so that the cups are even-sided.



2) Then, coat the base and sides of each overturned egg cup in the paint. We have used pink paint. Allow the paint to dry.



3) Next, use the black marker pen to drawn spots on your bug's body. We have used heart shaped spots.




4) Use the scissors to cut out two hearts from one piece of coloured card.




5) Add glue onto the top of the painted egg cups. Place the two card hearts over the glue, so that the points are facing each other and the arched tops of the hearts are facing away from the cup.

We have bent the card hearts slightly to create the wings of our Love Bugs. Allow the glue to dry.




6) Cut a small piece from the pipe cleaner, about 6cm long.




7) Bend the small piece of pipe cleaner into a V-shape. We have also bent the tips down slightly.

Add glue onto the flat front of the egg cup and place the bend pipe cleaner over the top.

This will create the antennae of your Love Bug.




8) Cut another heart shape from the second piece of coloured card.



9) Use the glue to secure two googly eyes onto the heart. Draw a smiling mouth under the eyes using the black marker pen.



10) Glue the heart face over the antennae of your Love Bug.



11) You could make your little Love Bugs in different colours or join three egg cups together to make a big Love Bug!
